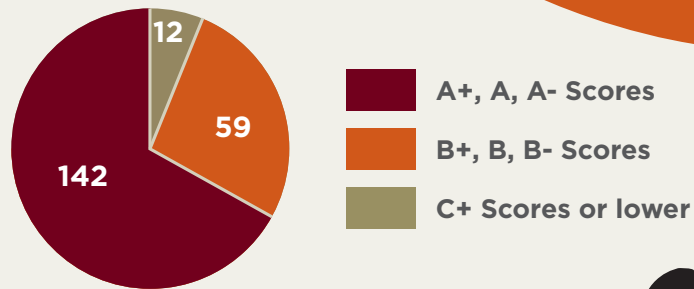
Promoting mastery over memorization:

94% of all grades received were an **A** or a **B** in an analysis of 2010 and 2015 high school report cards.

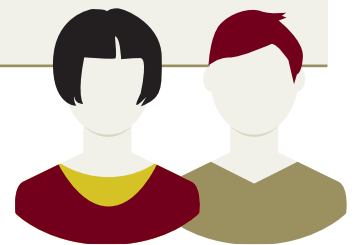
